MAMA'S OAR MAX'S

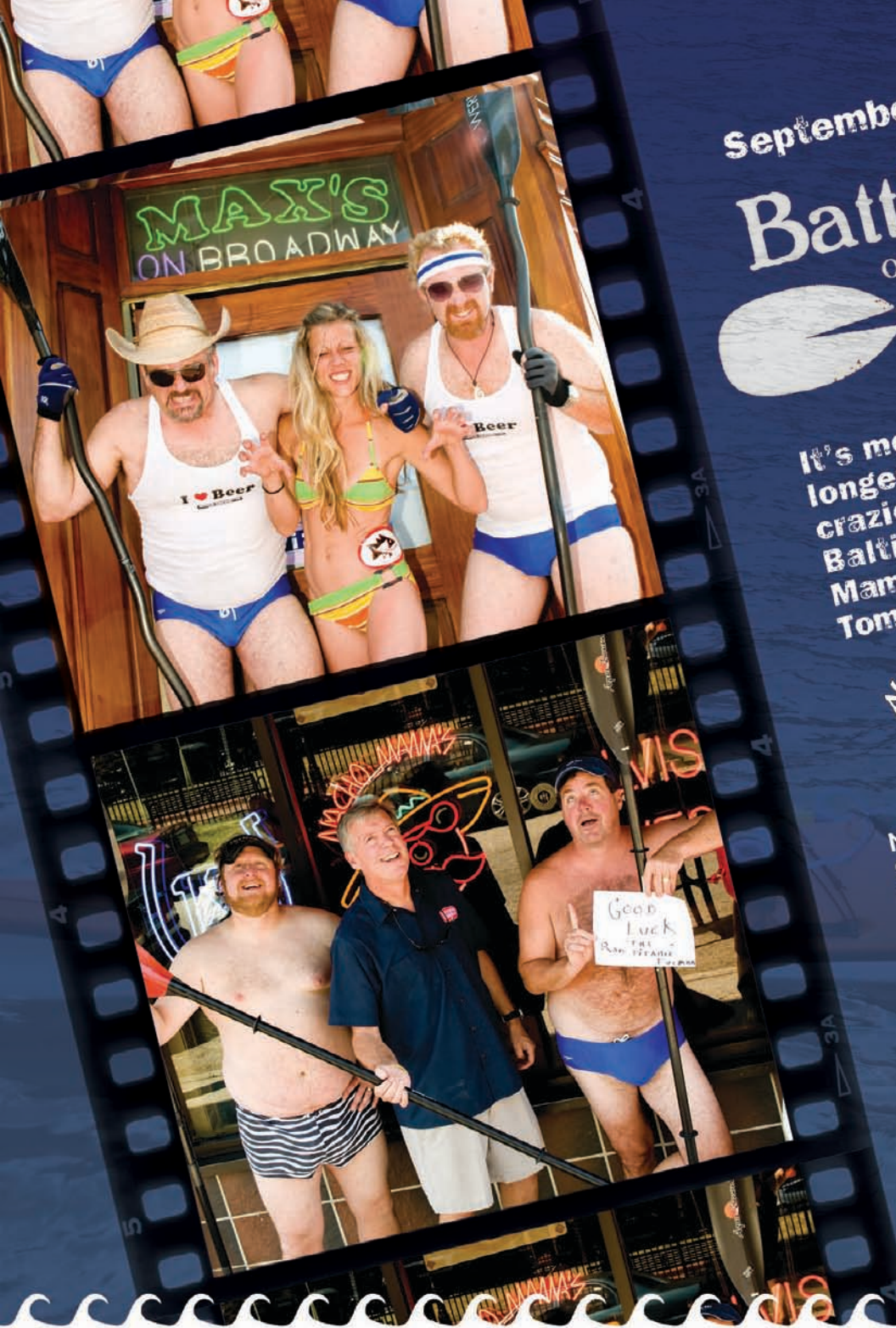
