Home will prioritize Military families battling a child's medical crisis.  
Goal is to open the Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls by October 2010.

The Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls will be the foundation's second respite property to prioritize military families with critically ill children.

In addition to featuring spectacular views, the Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls is situated close to trout streams, hiking trails, natural forest, a community clubhouse and outdoor swimming pools.
