**Believe In Tomorrow Children's Foundation to Open Doors of Expansive
Mountain-Top Oasis to Serve Military Families
With Critically Ill Children**

*The Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls, Outside Asheville, North Carolina, is the
Foundation's Second Respite Property to Prioritize Military Families
With Critically Ill Children*

(Baltimore, MD) Military Families with critically ill children will soon have another option for escaping the stress that accompanies a child's medical crisis when Believe In Tomorrow Children's Foundation (believeintomorrow.org) opens the doors of its seventh facility in December.

Located outside of Asheville, North Carolina, The Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls, is a 3,300 square foot fully furnished and appointed home that features three spacious bedrooms, a wrap around porch, multiple outdoor decks, an outdoor healing garden and a fire pit.

A national leader in pediatric hospital and respite housing services, Believe In Tomorrow Children's Foundation has provided over 560,000 individual overnight hospital and respite housing accommodations to families with critically ill children, from every state in the U.S. and 76 countries worldwide.

Believe In Tomorrow Children's Foundation created the concept of respite housing and currently maintains three beach properties along the shores of Maryland and Delaware and another mountain-top property overlooking Deep Creek Lake in Western, Maryland, families with critically ill children can utilize year round, free of charge.

"Because they are typically displaced from their home base, friends and family, military families are particularly vulnerable to the physical and emotional toll a child's life-threatening illness presents," said Believe In Tomorrow Founder and CEO, Brian Morrison.

Morrison continued, "Believe In Tomorrow opened the doors to the first respite property in the nation to prioritize military families with critically ill children in 2007 and we remain committed to serving the needs of military families who honor us with their dedication and service to our country."

Chris Brogan, Child Life Specialist for the Naval Medical Center in Portsmouth, VA, added, "Dealing with life-threatening disease impacts a family to its core. No one in the family is left untouched by the challenges that may continue from months to years. Parents must contemplate difficult choices. Brothers and sisters are shuffled around. All of them will be affected with the uncertainty and questions that permeate their lives...and then they go on a Believe In Tomorrow respite trip."

The development and completion of the Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls was made possible through donations, generous contributions and volunteerism. In the summer of 2009, a group of stone masons from Wisconsin drove 1,000 miles to North Carolina to donate the stone and construct the chimney on the house, which features the Believe In Tomorrow star.
