Children in Believe In Tomorrow's Hands On Adventures program will get to ride in the Wind Creek Casino and Hotel Blimp, which is one of less than 23 airships flying in the world today. The blimp rides will give a child who is battling a life threatening illness a once in a lifetime opportunity to experience something that is available by special invitation only. Seating on board a blimp cannot be purchased, at any price.

The Wind Creek Casino and Hotel Blimp flies along the Gulf Coast of the United States, with a flight plan that includes a focus on Alabama and the Florida Panhandle, which is home to many of our nation's military personnel.

"Thanks to the Wind Creek Casino and Hotel, we are thrilled to offer children in our program, such an extraordinary Hands on Adventure," said Believe In Tomorrow Founder and CEO, Brian Morrison. "We are aggressively looking to grow our respite housing initiative in the Gulf Coast area and the attention the blimp will generate helps us secure funding and support for that expansion."

Believe In Tomorrow National Children's Foundation provides long term hospital and respite housing for families with critically ill children and is the exclusive provider of hospital housing for the world renowned Johns Hopkins Children's Center.

The Foundation also has five respite properties along the Atlantic Ocean and in the mountains of Western Maryland and North Carolina, families with critically ill children can utilize free of charge to get away from the trauma of confronting a child's life threatening illness and relax in a soothing environment.

Two of the foundation's respite properties, the Believe In Tomorrow House on the Bay in Ocean City, MD and the Believe In Tomorrow House at Pinnacle Falls, near Asheville, North Carolina, prioritize military families with critically ill children.

"People have been captivated by blimps since the birth of these gigantic airships, and for those fortunate few who actually get to ride in an airship, it's an unforgettable experience. We are proud to support Believe In Tomorrow's work with military and all families who are in the throws of battling a child's critical illness," said Jay Dorris, CEO/President of PCI Gaming Authority.

The Wind Creek Casino & Hotel Blimp will be in Pensacola, FL on December 13 and Mobile, AL on December 20. Robert "Carl" Harbuck, is Captain of the airship. A decorated retired naval enlistee and an honored former US Army helicopter pilot, Harbuck has logged over 8300 hours in airships, 1,000 hours in helicopters and 130 hours in hot air balloons. The Wind Creek Hotel and Casino Blimp will be appearing in additional cities in the Gulf Coast region early next year. Guests on board the Wind Creek Hotel and Casino Blimp will feel very special – they will be one of seven passengers in the air, not counting Captain Harbuck.

Wind Creek Casino & Hotel is a massive 240,000 square foot facility, with 57,000 square feet of gaming floor and over 1,600 electronic gaming machines.
