Believe In Tomorrow also has five destination driven respite houses families can utilize free of charge to escape to the beach or the mountains to relax together and create joyful memories outside of a hospital or clinical environment.

The Team will be cleaning the Believe In Tomorrow House at St. Casimir, in Canton, MD, regularly as well as maintaining the outdoor areas of the property, which was formerly a convent. They are also "on call" for any odds and ends projects, like painting, moving furniture or seasonal needs.

The team is also spearheading a non-perishable food drive, preparing family suppers for guests staying at the facilities and hosting game nights. The team is working with Believe In Tomorrow to honor the memory of Vincent "Vinnie" Hillen, who spent time with his family at the Believe In Tomorrow House on Wisp Mountain. Vinnie's older brother Woodrow is on the team.
